## What is the PSAT test?

The PSAT is co-sponsored by the College Board and National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC), the Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test (NMSQT) — often shortened to PSAT — is a standardized test targeting 10th and 11th graders across the U.S.

## Why take it at all?

As it stands, the PSAT is heavily connected to the SAT. One of the test's primary purposes is to act as a precursor to the SAT — essentially, as an SAT practice test. Students will receive a score report which highlights their individual strengths and weaknesses and access to online SAT prep programs through College Board.

The PSAT also serves as a qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program. PSAT scores determine students' eligibility for National Merit scholarships. Each year the top 1 percent of 11<sup>th</sup> grade PSAT takers become Semifinalists. Of these students, 7,500 go on to win scholarship money.
