

Important Information Regarding State Testing

Attention all Middle School Families. This is a reminder that Middle School ELA testing will take place on Tuesday April 2nd and Wednesday April 3rd. All students, whether you are taking the test or whether you have already provided us with appropriate opting out documentation have been assigned to a classroom and are expected to be at this room assignment promptly by 7:54 on Tuesday Morning.

Students who are taking the exam should come prepared with sharpened #2 pencils and a book to read quietly if you finish the test early. **Do Not** bring any electronic devices, cell phones, or book bags into the testing classroom. Please make sure that these items are securely placed in your locker before entering the testing classroom.

Students who have already provided us with appropriate opting out documentation should enter their assigned classroom with a book to read silently during this testing period. **Do Not** bring any electronic devices, cell phones, or book bags into the classroom. Please make sure that these items are securely placed in your locker before entering the classroom.

Currently, we are no longer accepting any opt out forms leading up to the day of the test. Any last minute opt out requests will be handled on the first day of the test. Your child is expected to report on time to their assigned testing room. They will submit the form to the proctor and your child will be moved to an opt out classroom at that time.

Please be reminded that these two days are considered regular days of attendance. Students are expected to be in their testing rooms and opt out rooms promptly at 7:54. If your child arrives late to school, please be reminded to follow regular lateness procedures and provide your child with a valid excuse note as to why he or she is late to school.

On each of the testing days, students will be dismissed from their assigned classrooms and report to their Period 1 classes, which will start at 9:54. We will then follow a modified Period 1-9 schedule which will conclude with regular dismissal.
