

## EAST ISLIP HIGH SCHOOL SENIOR PROM CONTRACT

Students who participate in prom activities should recognize that they have an obligation to themselves, their classmates and the school community to act in a mature and responsible manner. Attendance at the senior prom should be a positive experience where students exhibit civil behavior, respect for others and mature judgment.

The following are expectations for all prom attendees. This includes all students of the East Islip High School District as well as their guests.

Students and guests attending the prom must:

1. Understand that participation in prom activities is a privilege and should be valued.
2. Understand and abide by the rules and regulations of the Code of Conduct that govern all school activities: Refrain from disorderly, disrespectful, disruptive or insubordinate behaviors.
3. Demonstrate respect for others including school supervisors and staff, catering staff and classmates.
4. Understand that they may not be in possession of or under the influence of any alcoholic beverages, drugs, narcotics or controlled substances. This applies to all individuals regardless of age. A breathalyzer will be used at the door to resolve issues regarding alcohol consumption. If a student refuses the administration of a breathalyzer test, he/she will be presumed to have consumed alcohol and processed in the same manner as if a positive test result had been obtained and the student will be excluded from the prom, prom-related activities and other school events. **Failure to meet these guidelines will result in a suspension from school. The suspension will effectively exclude the student from the graduation ceremony.**
5. Arrive no later than 7:45 p.m. or you will not be allowed to enter.
6. Understand that once you leave the prom, you will not be allowed to re-enter.
7. **Be responsible for their behavior. Students, therefore, who are found to have violated district policy and/or this contract, will face disciplinary actions, including suspension and a loss of privileges such as participation in the graduation ceremony as state above.**
8. Understand that if he/she is bringing a date who is not an East Islip High School student or an underclassman, he/she is responsible for the behavior of their date. As such, the misbehavior of a non EI student or an underclassman will result in consequences for the East Islip High School senior.

**Individual students or guests not meeting the guidelines set by the East Islip Union Free School District and the school administration will be removed from or denied entrance to the prom. Parents will be notified and arrangements will be made for the student to be sent home at their own expense.**
