Dear Parent/Guardian:

June Regents examinations are scheduled for Tuesday, June 18, 2019 through Tuesday, June 25, 2019. You will find a copy of the schedule as well as a testing week bus schedule in the virtual backpack.

It is important for your child to take all exams seriously and study. Please have your child arrive on time and prepared for the exam. In preparation for the upcoming Regents Examinations, I would like to remind you of some important information regarding State Regulations for communication devices.

Before exams can be distributed, proctors are required to read the following statement:

*You cannot have any communication device, including a cell phone, with you during this exam or during any breaks (such as a restroom visit). Such devices include, but are not limited to:*

- Cell phones
- iPods or other MP3 players
- iPads, tablets, and other eReaders
- Personal laptops, notebooks or any other computing devices
- Cameras, other photographic equipment, and scanning devices
- Wearable devices/smart wearables, including smart watches and health wearables with a display
- Headphones, headsets, or in-ear headphones such as earbuds, and
- Any other device capable of recording audio, photographic, or video content, or capable of viewing or playing back such content, or sending/receiving text, audio, or video messages

*If you brought any of these items to the building today and have not already turned it over to me, a test monitor or school official, you must give it to me now. You may not keep your cell phone or any of these items with you, or near you, including in your pockets, backpacks, desks, etc. **If you keep a cell phone or any of these items with you, your exam will be invalidated, and you will receive no score.** Is there anyone who needs to give me any of these items now? (Proctor: repeat the list of devices). This is your last opportunity to do so before the test begins.*

As indicated by the statement issued by the New York State Department of Education, students **cannot bring any electronic devices to the exams**. Students are expected to leave them at home. As a result, any electronic device that is brought to school during the testing period will have to be surrendered to school personnel until the examination is complete. Please be advised students will not have access to their locker during the examination period.
