Dear Parents,

As we begin our school year, I would like to take this opportunity to inform you of our practice regarding snacks in the classroom. Each teacher will establish a snack time and guidelines specific to his or her classroom. In order to provide for the safety of students who suffer from food allergies, attached to this letter you will see a list of classroom teachers with a corresponding list of the foods that may cause allergic reactions to some students in the class. As parents prepare daily snacks for their children, we are asking that they refrain from snacks containing the foods that may cause allergic reactions.

Our school nurse keeps an updated list of students who suffer from food allergies and the foods to which they are allergic. If the list changes during the school year, we will send a note to parents informing them of changes to the list of foods that should not be included in classroom snacks.

Additionally, I have asked each teacher to inform his or her parents of the classroom snack procedure for the year. Please join me in this important effort to provide for the safety and well-being of all our students as we begin our new year.
