Approved Special Business Meeting/Budget Workshop

April 10, 2014

(Meeting Chaired by Board of Education President)

The meeting will begin at 6:00 p.m. for the possible purpose of considering a motion to enter Executive Session to discuss confidential matters. If there is an Executive Session, the meeting will return to public session at approximately 7:00 p.m. to consider the agenda and all other items which may properly come before the Board of Education. The tentative agenda and supporting information for this meeting will be posted at www.eischools.org once it becomes available.

1. Call to Order by the Board President – Mr. Raffone called the meeting to order at 7:09 p.m.
2. Pledge of Allegiance – Mr. Raffone led those in attendance to the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. Action Items Recommended by the Superintendent of Schools
 - A. Motion by Mrs. Phillips to approve the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the resignations, terminations, leave of absence, position abolitions, employment appointments, tenure appointments, and salary changes in accordance with applicable provisions of Education Law and Civil Service Law, as follows: Motion by Mr. Reed to approve Items 1-3 in the Certified Personnel Report; Seconded by Mr. Montuori and unanimously approved. Mr. Montuori asked if these appointments were for the regents to which Mrs. Becker-Santa responded yes, they are for regents review classes. Motion by Mr. Behan to approve Items 1-6 in the Non-Certified Personnel Report; Seconded by Mrs. Phillips and unanimously approved.
 - B. Board of Education Response to Budget Advisory Committee

Mrs. Rozzi thanked everyone for coming this evening and recognized the members of the Budget Advisory Committee; Mrs. Aileen D'Addario (not in attendance), Michele Pandolfo, William Schreiner, Christopher Zachary, Michael Steves, Matthew Calarco, John Milito and Mr. Fraser, co-chair. Mrs. Rozzi thanked them for their diligent work and terrific job they did in presenting their recommendations to the Board of Education. She stated that all of the recommendations were taken very seriously and believes that together with their input as well as the expertise of the Board of Education we will be able to present a budget to voters in May that is fiscally responsible, tax cap-compliant, and one that preserves and enhances programs for our students. She stated that she will be presenting the Superintendent's Recommended Budget on April 24, 2014. Mrs. Rozzi shared a PowerPoint presentation of the District's response to the Budget Advisory Committee's recommendations and noted that the budget still must be adopted and voter approved. Mrs. Rozzi reminded everyone of the dates for the 2014-2015 Budget Calendar; April 24- Budget Adoption; May 13-Budget Hearing and May 20- Budget Vote which will be held at the Early Childhood Center.
