6. ACTION ITEMS RECOMMENDED BY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS

- A. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education, having received timely and written notification from Mrs. Linda J. Rozzi, hereby accepts with regrets her resignation as the Superintendent of Schools of the East Islip Union Free School District, effective June 30th, 2015 to assume the Superintendent's post in the Babylon Union Free School District, effective July 1st, 2015.
- B. BE IT RESOLVED that the President of the Board of Education is authorized to execute a certain agreement with the United Public Service Employees Union and a unit member, dated April 2, 2015, regarding a retirement issue.
- C. BE IT RESOLVED that the President of the Board of Education is authorized to execute an agreement between the East Islip Union Free School District and the East Islip Teachers' Association dated April 14, 2015 regarding Coaching and Extracurricular pay.
- D. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the resignations, terminations, leaves of absence, position abolitions, employment appointments, tenure appointments, and salary changes in accordance with applicable provisions of Education Law and Civil Service Law, as cited in the Personnel Changes attachment.
- E. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the abolishment of Policy #9310-Physical & Mental Exams.
- F. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the abolishment of Policy #4720 Testing Programs.
- G. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education accepts the Treasurer's Report for the month of February 2015.
- H. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education accepts the Extra Classroom Activity Funds Report for the month of February 2015.
- I. The proposed budget for 2015-16 is \$111,076,458. This figure reflects an increase over the 2014-15 budget of \$290,809 or .26%. The estimated tax levy for 2015-16 is \$70,428,345, which is an increase of \$671,479 or .96% over 2014-15. This increase is within the calculated maximum tax levy cap. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education adopts the budget for the 2015-16 school year with proposed expenses of \$111,076,458.
- J. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education, as required by State Education Law Sections 1608, 1716(7) and 2601-a(3), approves the Property Tax Report Card for the 2015-16 school year.

- K. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the Standard Work Day and Reporting Resolution 2014-15 as required by the New York State Comptroller's Office for the District's Treasurer and Deputy Treasurer. This resolution must be approved each school year for these appointed positions.
- L. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the Health Services Contract with Bay Shore Union Free School District for the 2014-15 school year. This contract is for health services provided to fifteen of our students who attend St. Patrick School located in the Bay Shore School District. The cost is \$10,740.30 and will be paid from the general fund.
- M. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the Health Services Contract with Smithtown Central School District for health services provided to six of our students who attend Smithtown Christian School located in Smithtown School District for the 2014-15 school year. The total cost is \$5017.26 and will be paid from the general fund.
- N. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the Health Services Contract with South Huntington Union Free School District for health services provided to thirty seven of our students who attend St. Anthony's High School and three of our students who attend the Long Island School for the Gifted located in South Huntington School District for the 2014-15 school year. The total cost is \$29,693.60 and will be paid from the general fund.
- O. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the translator contract with Jorge I. Jimenez which will be providing translator services as needed in the 2014-2015 school year. The fees for these services are listed on Appendix A. This expense will be paid from the general fund.
- P. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the Joint Municipal Cooperative Bidding Program Resolution (A), Exhibit 1 from BOCES for the 2015-2016 school year. The cost of this service is \$8,650 which is a 2% increase over the current school year. This cost is included in the Shared Services Contract with Eastern Suffolk BOCES and will be paid from the General Fund.

- R. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the one year bid extension from June 12, 2015 to June 11, 2016 at the current bid prices for Bid#042214-1 Roof (Rubber Membrane) Repair, Maintenance and Service with Sound Roof Systems LTD.
- S. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education accepts the donation of \$666 from eiMAPs to the East Islip School District's Art & Music Programs. This donation will be used to help defray the cost of the printing of the High School Musical's Program. The monies will be deposited into the High School Musical Account.
- T. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education accepts the donation of \$1,000 from the Syncopated Foundation to the East Islip School District. The donation will be used to purchase instruments for the Music Department district wide totaling \$900. The revenue code to be increased is 2705.000 and the budget code to be increased is 2110-200-09-5380. The balance of \$100 will be split evenly between the High School Music Senior Scholarship and High School Art Senior Scholarship accounts. The Trust and Agency Account numbers to be increased are 090.09 (Art) and 090.10 (Music).
- U. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education accepts the donation of a 4/4 violin, case and bow from Mr. Patrick Flamio, a district resident, to the East Islip Music Department. The violin and equipment is estimated to be valued at \$300 and will be used by students' district wide.
- V. BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education approves the disposal of two portable backboards located at the Middle School auxiliary gymnasium. These backboards are unsafe and have been replaced with permanent backboards.
- W. The Social Studies textbooks are damaged and are no longer fit for student use.
