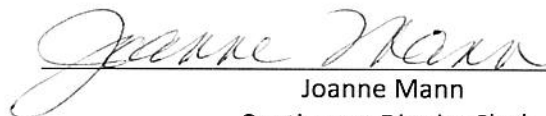
**APPROVED MINUTES
